As the lens in the eye ages, is traumatized, or suffers the effects of certain medications, it forms a cataract, which causes cloudy vision. The remedy for cataracts is surgical excision, which is managed by an eye surgeon, an ophthalmologist.

It's important for your ophthalmologist to be experienced with cataract surgery. The surgeon should explain the procedure and answer all of your questions. A thorough eye exam should be performed prior to scheduling cataract surgery.
